The Human Rights and Equality Grant Scheme 2017 aims to encourage leadership and excellence with a view to creating a deeper culture of human rights and equality in Ireland. It will support eligible activities that relate to one or both of the themes of:

- Intercultural Understanding and Diversity promoting awareness and understanding of interculturalism and supporting effective, positive intercultural relations in Ireland
- Supporting the Implementation of the Public Sector Duty promoting awareness and understanding of the Duty
